<b>TRANSPORTATION</b>

Are bathrooms/ toilets shared? Acceptable?	
Will there be Ukr. students in the same building/ floor/ unit?	
How long would students stay in a “dorm”?	
Is there a cafeteria in the dorm or would they need to walk there? If so, how far (time/ dist)?	
Will they stay also with host families? - how long, how many (1 student/ 1 fam.)?	
Cost of host families?	
Does the University have previous experience with host families for foreign students? How long was the stay? How many students? From what country?	
Other notes on host families/ housing	

<b>MEALS</b>	
Where will students eat?	
How many meals can be arranged by the program? How many on their own?	
Would they share a meal facility with Ukr. students?	
What menu is available – would it accommodate sensitive stomachs?	
What is the cost of 3 meals per day per student?	
What other meal options there are at the Univ.	
Other options in town – how many? How far? Average cost?	
Most common health issues with food....?	
Should students bring some snacks for craving? Why yes, why not?	
<b>COMMUNICATION</b>	
Are phones available for students to call home? At the dorm? Or at the Univ.?	
Can students use public phones to call home?	
What is the cost of calling US?	
Is email available at the Univ. for students to use?	
How often is it available? Is it an IT lab? Is it open on weekends?	
Do they have Cyber Cafes in town that students can use – are they accessible to them? Are they safe to go to, to be used by foreigners, etc?

<b>HEALTH CARE</b>	
Hospital – how far from student housing?	
Does the Univ. have their own nurse/ doctor's office for any outpatient cases?	
Nearest ER?	
Cost of health care for foreign visitors?	
Availability of h.care for foreigners?	
Does dorm have first aid kit? Emergency communication in place?

<b>FINANCES</b>	
How much pocket money (\$) students need for 2 weeks?	
Do they need to bring Ukr. currency? If so, how much?	
Do they need to bring only US bank notes for exchanging at the local bank?	
Any ATMs to use?	
If not, where else can they get cash?	
Are credit cards accepted? If so, at what places?	
Bank/ exch. counter opening hours?	
Other remarks on money....	
<b>PROGRAM FACILITATION</b>	
Who will be with the group for 2 weeks?	
Experienced with foreign students?	
Speaks English? Age?	
How much this person needs to be paid?	
Does the group need interpreter? How often?	
What is the cost of interpreter?	
Who can provide on-site arrival orientation on local rules, customs, safety, culture, other?	
<b>SAFETY ISSUES</b>	
Advice for US visitors moving around? Who can supply for pre-departure orientation?	
Special advice for women-students? For guys?	
<b>CULTURAL SITE VISITS INCL. KIEV</b>	
Options?	
Cost (incl. entrance, transport, escort)?	
Length? Distance?	
Importance of Site(s)?
